How Two IBC Members and American Brittany Rescue Helped a Stray Brittany

On October 5, 2008 I received an email from Chris Burchett letting me know about two stray Brittanys at a vet clinic in Osceola. When I called the vet clinic the next day and talked to the receptionist, I learned that the two orange and white females were brought to the vet clinic as strays on September 1 by a woman who found them a couple of weeks before that. The woman had gone door to door in her country neighborhood asking if they belonged to anyone and ran ads in several newspapers but no one claimed the dogs. Since the receptionist at the vet clinic had never heard of American Brittany Rescue, I told her a little about us and what we do. She said she would be happy to release the dogs to ABR.

I contacted the ABR state coordinator, Terry Mixdorf, to see if we could find foster homes for these two Britts. The next week I called the vet clinic to let them know that ABR had foster homes for the two britts and learned that the younger female had been adopted by a local person. I also learned that the Middle aged female had a hernia and the clinic was willing to remove it before placing her in foster care. They would schedule the surgery as soon as they could fit it into their schedule which turned out to be a couple of weeks later. During that time, another ABR volunteer from the Des Moines area drove down to Osceola to meet the Britt and evaluate her temperament with other dogs and cats. After recovering from surgery, the middle added Britt arrived in her ABR foster home on November 8! I have heard that she is settling into her foster home quite nicely and will be available for adoption soon. Thanks to Chris Burchett this stray Britt is on her way to a loving forever home. There are many ways YOU can help Britts in Iowa who don't have a forever home-yet. Maybe you could consider fostering a homeless Brittany? Britts usually remain in foster homes for 4-6weeks before finding their forever home. Maybe you could help with transporting a Britt from a shelter to its foster home...or from its foster home to its forever home? Maybe you could conduct a home visit of a potential adopter?
