Owned by Ken & Jane Windom of Cambridge, Iowa was nominated and elected to the 2008 Iowa Brittany Club Notable Dog List.

Chief's accomplishments include: 6 Championship/Classic Wins and 1 Runner Up win. 2X ABC Gun Dog Classic Winner, 3X Prairie State Shooting Dog Winner, 1X Michigan Shooting Dog Winner and 1X Runner Up. He won Iowa Brittany Club Dog of the Year Awards in 3 different categories, 6 different years, including Dual Dog, Gun Dog, and All Age Dog. He was also the Kentucky Field Trial Association Dog of the Year (Brittany) in 1998. Chief won the ABC National Dual Dog Award and he was a 2X winner of Best Dual at the National Specialty. He had many field trial and show placements throughout his career. Chief placed in both Gun Dog and All Age stakes all throughout the East Central, Central, and Midwest Regions.

Chief's offspring include: 6 DC, 8 FC, 22 CH, 33 JH, 2 SH, 3MH, 1 AX, 1 AXJ, 1 CD, 1 RA, 1 OA, 1 OAJ, 1 UDx2. He sired a 2X winner of the Chicken Classic, Purina Award Winner, Runner Up in the National All Age Championship - DC/AFC Bourbon XIII, 3X High in Trial Obedience at ABC National Specialty Show- DC Lafayette's Border Baron UDX2 MH, Michigan Shooting Dog Championship Winner, and many other Hour and

Championship Winners including National Gun Dog Placements. Only 3 dogs to date have sired more Dual Champions than Chief in ABC history.

Chief's Grand Get include: 2 DC, 4 CH, 5 FC, 2 AmFldCh., and 3AFC. He is the grandsire of ABC National Specialty Winner, #1 Show Brittany, 2X ABC Summer Specialty Winner- BIS/BISS/CH Sanbar's Call When Readi, Kansas All Age Championship Winner, Prairie State Shooting Dog Championship Winner, Michigan Shooting Dog Championship Runner Up, and many other Hour and Championship Winners.

Chief was a very accomplished dog in the field and show but also in his progeny record. He was dearly loved by many people and greatly feared by his competitors.

A great quote from someone in the gallery that I will never forget as it was my first field trial, "He can eat out of my feed bowl any day." Chief won that day with 4 finds and a spectacular run. This happened a day following Ken killing a dozen birds at the hunt club he is a member of.
